An American Hero—Ken Masters —co-editor Tim McCarthy

On January 17 Ken Masters, Maryland House Majority Leader, better to known to us as our longtime legal advocatepassed away. Ken's biography in the Baltimore Sun contained information many of us never heard before. We knew he served in Vietnam, but how many of us knew that he was awarded the Bronze Star and the Oakleaf Cluster or that he was appointed Secretary to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Commission. He didn't boast. He didn't need to.

Most of us knew, as Father

Whatley mentioned, that ,"He had a grace for resolving tensions. Though he was an accomplished attorney and politician, he was basically humble."

His humility may best be illustrated in the story he told to only a few. In 1991 a sweeping law empowering abortion came to Maryland. It forced our Catholic Hospitals to set aside their religious creeds and abort the unborn.

Ken sought out Ken Montague, a fellow Catholic of great

influence in Baltimore City .Then our Ken spoke into the record the words that spared our Catholic Hospitals from closing down for good. When Delegate Montague concurred the amendment passed and the Catholic Hospital system as we know it today was saved.

When Ken Masters passed away last month we lost more than a faithful friend. We lost a hero.
