Maryland was called the Free State because at its 1634 founding you could practice any religion you chose. But by 1676 things had changed. Over here a Catholic priest faced a fine of 200 pounds for saying Mass in public or 6 months in jail.

Back in England things were worse. A man named Titus Oates invented a scam that the Jesuits were trying to murder the Protestant King so that the king's Catholic brother (a convert) James would be king. In star chamber proceedings permitted by Charles the Second Oates had seven Jesuits, a Benedictine, a Franciscan and seven parish priests murdered by hanging. This was known as the Popish Plot.
